(<http://www.nps.gov/gett/>) \$7.50 adults \$6.00 students

Directions: Gettysburg National Military Park is located in Adams County, Pennsylvania. The museum and visitor center is located at **1195 Baltimore Pike** (Route 97) with a back entrance from the Taneytown Road (State Rt. 134).

From North or South, follow US 15 to Gettysburg and watch for signs to direct you to the National Park Service Museum and Visitor Center. The signs are near the exit at Rt. 97. Go north on Route 97 and look for the visitor center entrance, which will be on your left at the stoplight. From East or West, drive into Gettysburg on US Rt. 30, turn South on Baltimore Street (Rt. 97), and follow signs to the entrance of the visitor center, which will be on your right at the stoplight.

LIE (495) to the Cross Island Pkwy – to the Throgs Neck Bridge
Go Route 95 to Cross Bronx Expy towards the George Washington Bridge
Take the George Washington Bridge to the New Jersey Tpke, 95 South 10 miles
To I-78 West 137 miles
Merge onto I-81 south via exit on left toward Harrisburg 73 miles
Exit I-81 at US30
Turn left (East) onto US 30 (Lincoln Highway) 11.5 miles
Turn left (North) onto SR-234 (Buchanan Valley Rd.) 2.6 miles
Turn left (North-west) onto Mountain Road .06 miles
