

Camp Duty Roster

All are needed to work together for the following:

- Firewood for cooking
- Patrol Area clean
- Patrol Boxes clean
- Tents neat, 2 full fire buckets at each
- Troop Job Assignment each day.

Troop Jobs assigned to Patrols:

- Water – for general use
- Drink – mix, water, ice
- Latrine – daily clean-up
- Site clean-up and maintenance

Also,

- Campfire – Help to Build fire, Patrols prepare Skit, Song, or Game.

Each Patrol site should be flying their Patrol Flag.

Patrol Duty Roster (each Scout is assigned one job for the day, jobs are rotated every day):

Grub Hustler – wakes-up the Fire Builder, then goes for the food

Cook – prepares the meal, and make sure that the patrol box is clean and in order after the meal.

Assistant Cook / Waiter – helps the Cook and goes for any water needed for that meal,

Sets the Table for the meal,

invites the guests for the meal (Adults and Senior Patrol members),

Serves the meal if required. Leads the Patrol in Grace.

Fire Builder – makes the fire inside the stove for cooking, keeps it going, and cleans out the ashes after it cools down.

For dinner, if Heater Stacks: the Fire Builder becomes the Assistant Grub Hustler.

KP – Cleans the pots and utensils used for a meal at the Troop cleaning station, and then returns those items back to the patrol box.

Assistant KP - Stove top cleanup – clean the cooking surface after each meal and cleans / wipes-down the table after the meal.
