

## Pre Summer Camp Meeting

- **Payment** (by check or through your Troop Account)... See Laura Livote
- Make Appointment for your **medical physical**, pick-up form at meeting.
- **Sign-up** for Camp at meeting – we need to know who is going, even if you haven't paid yet.
- mosquito netting , the Troop will order through Campmor (\$10)
  - The netting **is required** - Let us know if need one
- Also, you need to provide the following set-up for the netting:
  - four 4-foot long dowels (5/8 inch diameter)
  - ground cloth (plastic sheet for under bunk to keep mosquitoes from coming up from under the floor boards), duct-tape (one roll for patrol)
- Scout Uniforms
  - Shorts, short sleeve shirt (one is enough)
  - Scout socks, ankle high (at least 2 pair)
  - Class 'B' Troop T-Shirt, Troop hat, Troop neckerchief
- Hiking Boots
  - water-proof, if they are new... start breaking them in now
- Pack equipment in: large duffel-bag, hockey-bag, foot locker
  - if bringing a foot locker, give spare keys to Adult Leader.
  - foot locker keeps things in better order and also makes a good table or stool inside the scout's tent at camp.
  - foot locker is also nice for storing camping gear year-round, between weekend trips.
- Campmor is an easy place to go for equipment

... Or contact Al at the Troop meeting (or home an order through the Troop.  
You need to supply Al with the item number, item description, size, color, cost per item, quantity (as required).  
Troop orders are tax-free with a 10% discount.  
Merchandise is delivered, usually within 2 weeks. See Al for more details.



### Other items that are a must to bring:

- Rain gear
- Mosquito Repellent – very import in the morning and especially at night. Non-Aerosol (pump-type okay) *Off*, or *Cutter* brands with only 4 – 5 % Deet should work for most. Do not apply in tent, it will remove the water-proofing if sprayed on the tent.
- Belt clip for their pocket knife is an easy way to prevent misplacing a pocket knife.
- Pens and paper – very important, since most merit badges require some paper-work.
